This Prospectus Supplement dated 27 July 2022 (the “**Prospectus Supplement**” or “**Prospectus Supplement No. 3**”) to the Base Prospectus dated 9 November 2021 (as supplemented by the Prospectus Supplement No. 1 dated 3 February 2022 and the Prospectus Supplement No. 2 dated 29 April 2022, together with the Prospectus Supplement, the “**Base Prospectus**”) constitutes a supplement for the purposes of Regulation (EU) 2017/1129 (the “**Prospectus Regulation**”) and is prepared in connection with the Global Covered Bond Programme (the “**Programme**”) established by Danske Bank A/S (the “**Issuer**”). Terms defined in the Base Prospectus have the same meaning when used in this Prospectus Supplement.

This Prospectus Supplement has been approved by the Central Bank of Ireland as competent authority under the Prospectus Regulation. The Central Bank of Ireland only approves this Prospectus Supplement as meeting the requirements imposed under Irish and European law pursuant to the Prospectus Regulation. The Central Bank of Ireland only approves this Prospectus Supplement as meeting the standards of completeness, comprehensibility and consistency imposed by the Prospectus Regulation. Such approval should not be considered as an endorsement of the Issuer or the securities that are the subject of this Prospectus Supplement.

The Issuer accepts responsibility for the information contained in this Prospectus Supplement. To the best of the knowledge of the Issuer, the information contained in this Prospectus Supplement is in accordance with the facts and contains no omission likely to affect its import. Save as disclosed in this Prospectus Supplement, there has been no other significant new factor, material mistake or inaccuracy relating to information included in the Base Prospectus since the publication of the Base Prospectus.
